HIGH SCHOOLS

The boundaries for senior high school attendance areas are as follows:

The boundary line between the two high schools will be Divide Avenue extended from the Missouri River east to Centennial Drive and south to the Apple Creek and Gibbs township line going east.

Those high school students living within the Bismarck School District, south of the Divide Avenue boundary, will attend Bismarck High School.

Those high school students living within the Bismarck School District, north of the Divide Avenue boundary, will attend Century High School.

All high school students outside of the Bismarck School District, but residing in Burleigh County, will attend Century High School.
