

District Sound & Light Technician

Purpose Statement

The job of District Sound and Light Technician is done for the purpose/s of providing maintenance services with specific responsibility for providing technical expertise and assistance to staff, students and community groups in the use of the theater; operating, repairing, maintaining and rigging theatrical equipment; and performing other work related to theater maintenance.

This job reports to the building Activities Director at each high school.

Essential Functions

- Advises students, other site personnel and community clients for the purpose of providing information regarding safety, facility maintenance and use, and theater activities.
- Assists clients for the purpose of designing, implementing and supporting lighting and sound technical needs in a production.
- Operates theatrical lighting and sound systems (e.g. audio systems, specialized audio equipment, digital lighting systems, etc.) for the purpose of providing the necessary support to theater productions.
- Designs, adapts and installs theatrical lighting and sound systems for the purpose of providing the necessary support to theater productions.
- Maintains tools and equipment for the purpose of ensuring availability in safe operating condition.
- Performs other related duties as assigned for the purpose of ensuring the efficient and effective functioning of the work unit.

Qualifications:

Current high school student or community member with experience as a theater technician.

Individual(s) hired will work primarily on the weekends on an as-needed basis.
