

# How to Find Instructional Reading Level (Fountas and Pinnell) in Viewpoint

1. Log into viewpoint
2. Select School and grade level  
--Optional: Select Teacher
3. Click on Test Performance on left-hand side

  - a. Test: Common Assessment

  - e. Scale: IRL Grade –this must match your selected grade in Step 2 (\*If no data is available, and your Season is from last year, try changing your Scales to prior grade, this seems to happen in middle and high school)

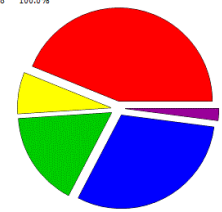


5. A Pie Chart will now show up
