**Treasurer's Report:** Angela provided an account report our current balance as of Oct. 5, 2023 is \$9,027.39.

**New Business:**

- Haunted Carnival
  - Same pricing as last year for tickets and games
  - Sign up Genius have all been set up
  - Silent Auction -teachers have sent out notifications on class themes for baskets.
    - Still looking for outside of the classroom basket donations.
  - Reprint signs for buckets, already made just need to print and laminate
  - All prizes and tickets have been bought
  - Concessions - Cash not ticket to purchase
    - popcorn, pizza, small individual bags of chips, Halloween desert (allergy friendly)
    - Adding cloverdale pulled pork instead of hot dogs that did NOT go over well last year.
      - Asking if Cloverdale will donate-TBD
      - Will need to get Buns, BBQ sauce

- Drinks- Pop, water, powerade or other kid friendly option
    - Games
      - Angry Birds game is broken
      - 8 games from last year: Plinko, Fishing booth, Sucker pull, Cake walk, golf, football toss, ring toss (doing bottle of pop instead of witch hats if we can get sponsor to cover cost) Something for older kids to win the bottle of pop.
      - Adding a few more games:
        - Pick a Duck -Need a kiddie pool for 1" worth of water in an area where there's no carpet. Outside between cake walk perhaps weather permitting. Tabby has ok'd.
        - Corn Hole
        - Face painting- Asking Theo Art School to volunteer to paint simple designs or characters. OR we buy paint and supplies and ask volunteers such as older kids to paint.
      - Add new games to sign up genius
      - Using 2 more class rooms this year to create more space.
    - Setting up the night before on Friday. Time TBD.
- Sponsorship Committee
  - Sponsorships last year were just for the Haunted Carnival. Our goal for this year is to be for more events.
  - It was decided to use the back side of a white banner we already have and laminate sponsors name/logo and tape it to the banner to be hung at school?
  - Utilize the TV and Youtube to create a show thanking our sponsors.
  - Once PTC gets a projection screen put up, use that screen during events to showcase sponsors.
  - Still looking for sponsors and communicating that out to the community.
    - Kassie is asking her connection at Coke
- Legacy Purchase
  - Each year PTC would like to make a Legacy Purchase and this year the idea of a projection screen was brought up. This projection screen would be hung in the gym to be utilized for projects, programs, and any events held at PR.
  - In the future we would like to see the Student Council become a part of the decision making process for this purchase.
  - We want to have a goal for a big school purchase so parents know what we are fundraising for and understand the money is going to be used to make PR a better place for our students.
  - It was decided by a unanimous vote to approve \$3,000 to place the order to purchase the projector, screen and installation, through BPS Technology Director.
  - Estimated time frame for installation would be spring.
