## CAREER CAFE

Several years ago, Sunrise Elementary School began "serving up" something new. We started hosting a weekly Career Café during the student lunch hour. This program helps build a connect for students between academic skills and future opportunities. It provides an opportunity for students in 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade to meet individuals from the community and learn about their careers.

Starting in October, Career Café will be held on Mondays from 12:30 p.m. - 1:25 p.m. Guests will be speaking for approximately 25 minutes with two separate groups of students while the students eat lunch. Speakers will share their career journey with students, including how they became interested in their current field, what education/training they needed, what they do in a typical day at their job, and advice they have for students considering a job in their field. Since our goal is to provide the students with an introduction to many different options, we will only be scheduling one presenter from each career area.
