Bismarck High School is a public school with enrollments of approximately 1200 students in grades 9, 10, 11, and 12. The Bismarck School District requires a minimum of 24 credits for graduation in grades 9 through 12. Courses are required in the following areas:

English	4 credits
Science	3 credits
Math	3 credits
Social Studies	3 credits
Physical Education	2 credits
Foreign Language, Fine Arts, CTE	3 credits

Advanced Placement courses are offered in Biology, AB Calculus, BC Calculus, Chemistry, **Environmental Science, Computer Science A, Computer Science Principals, English 11** (Language), English 12 (Literature), Government, Psychology, Physics 1 and US History. Classes are noted on the transcript with "AP." Students can accelerate in mathematics and English and there are three honors courses: Enriched Algebra II, Enriched Pre-calculus, and Honors English 10. Dual credit is available for the following courses: College Algebra, Computer Programming II, Probability and Statistics, Speech, Web Page Design, Medical Terminology, AP Biology, Prevention and Care of Athletic Injuries.

Bismarck High School uses the following grading system:

AP Courses are weighted on a 5.0 scale. Seniors are ranked on the basis of grade point averages for all classes taken in grades 9, 10, 11 and first semester of grade 12. Students who have a combined grade point average of 4.0 or higher will earn a class rank of "1" and be recognized as valedictorians. All students who have a combined grade point average of 3.75 are recognized as graduating with highest distinction.

Approximately 70% of seniors pursue further education immediately after high school.
