Announcing the North Dakota Scholars Program

To be eligible for consideration:

- You must meet North Dakota residency requirements and graduate from a North Dakota high school in the 2019–2020 academic year.
- You must plan to attend a North Dakota college or university during the 2020–2021 academic year as a full time student.
- You must take (or have taken) the ACT® test on one of the dates in the opposite column, and no later than July 1, 2019.

This program recognizes outstanding North Dakota high school seniors for scholastic achievement as measured by their ACT scores.

Scholars will be announced in fall 2019 and will receive a letter from the North Dakota University System designating them as North Dakota Scholars. North Dakota Scholars who enroll in a North Dakota college or university will be awarded an in-state tuition scholarship. Students who attend a private institution will be awarded an amount not to exceed the highest public school rate in the state. Selection of students as scholars will be based on their ACT scores. Not all students who place in the top ninety-fifth percentile will be awarded the North Dakota Scholars award due to limited funding. Awards are based on legislative appropriations.
