Qualifications

- Must be a high school sophomore, junior or senior
- Must have at least a cumulative 2.0 GPA
- Must meet any course placement score and/or prerequisites

An Associate of Science degree

is ideal for students wanting to further their education in science, technology, engineering, mathematics or medicine.
