

School Assignment

Residence is defined as the attendance area in which the parent/guardian of the students have their primary residence.

Parents shall enroll their children in the school(s) in their residency area, the boundaries of which are determined annually by the School Board prior to March 15. Requests for transferring children into a school in another attendance area will be decided as per administrative regulations. These regulations shall address transfers made before and during the school year and student relocation before and during the school year.

The Board reserves the authority to transfer students from one attendance area to another when enrollment must be balanced because of classroom space requirements and when children must be involved in special programs such as special education. Transfer decisions shall comply with 20 U.S.C. 1703.

Extracurricular Eligibility

The District shall comply with all North Dakota High School Activities Association (NDHSAA) regulations regarding transfer student's eligibility for NDHSAA sponsored programs and events.
