

### **Adult Education**

The District may offer an adult education program, which shall conform to standards in law. The program shall be made available upon the Superintendent's or designee's approval to individuals over the age of sixteen who are unable to attend public school. The Superintendent shall develop criteria defining "inability to attend public school."

Students enrolled in the adult education program will be required to abide by all applicable district policies. Classes may be held in the day or evening and shall not interfere with the operation of the regular education program.

The District may charge a reasonable tuition fee for participation in the adult education program. The fee will include the cost of books and materials needed to administer the program. The Superintendent may waive the fee on a case-by-case basis for hardship reasons.

The program shall be administered by the Superintendent through the Director of Adult Education. To implement this program, the Superintendent may seek assistance from and/or partner with community higher education institutions through use of cooperative agreements and through the pooling of district and higher education resources, including, but not limited to, facilities, personnel, and instructional resources.
