

Curriculum Adoption

Annually, after reviewing the recommendations of the Instructional Design Team (IDT), budgetary data, other pertinent information, and ensuring the curriculum meets all requirements under district policy and law, the Board shall vote on changes to the curriculum for the upcoming school year. The Superintendent or designee shall assist in this process to ensure the curriculum is comprehensive and meets all applicable legal requirements.

During the course of the school year, the Assistant Superintendents and committees may suggest improvements and changes to the curriculum, and such changes may be implemented administratively by the Superintendent and or designee(s) as the Superintendent deems necessary and educationally sound. The Superintendent shall report to the Board prior to implementing such changes.
