

**Selection of Supplementary Classroom
Curricular and Co-Curricular Materials**

Examples of supplementary materials include books, videos, DVD's, newspapers, magazines, software, and other AV items.

1. Supplementary materials selected by a committee or individual teachers should also be chosen with the general considerations listed in School Board Policy.
2. Supplementary rated materials, whether purchased by the district, rented, or brought from home, will use the guidelines in policy GBBB and rule GBBB-AR.
3. All material shown during instructional time must be directly related to the curriculum and should not be used for entertainment purposes. All material must meet grade-level guidelines.
4. The classroom teacher must preview all material prior to use to determine if it is age appropriate and if the material supports the adopted curriculum of the District.
5. All media must be used within legal copyright limits in accordance with the most recent copyright laws. (See School Board Policy ABCA).
