

Parent Conferences and Progress Reports

The Board recognizes the importance of parent-teacher conferences. At least one parent-teacher conference shall be scheduled each year for parents of students in the schools. To accommodate such conferences, the schools may close for certain days each year. These conference days shall be set by the Superintendent in consultation with school principals.

The teacher shall arrange additional conferences with parents in instances when children are having learning or behavior problems.

The type of progress reports sent to parents shall be developed by the professional staff and approved by the superintendent.

A written report shall be provided to parents three times a year at the K-5 grade levels and four times a year at the 6-12 grade levels, with supplementary reports as needed. Conferences with parents also shall be used at the elementary level as a part of the reporting system.
