1. Quality of product.
2. Suitability of product.
3. Price.
4. Conformance to specifications.
5. Convenience of delivery.
6. General reputation of business firms.
7. Quality of maintenance services.
8. Past services to the school district.

The district purchasing agent should not feel bound to purchase any item locally that can be secured at a saving to the district from outside sources.
