

Educational Specifications

To ensure that all new and remodeled facilities in the Bismarck School District are designed to best implement the educational program, the Superintendent will provide for the development of detailed educational specifications to apply to the design and construction of new and remodeled buildings.

Educational specifications are detailed descriptions of:

1. The activities that will take place in the building;
2. The curriculum to be housed in the building;
3. Specific architectural characteristics desired;
4. The facilities needed, their equipment requirements and their space relationship to other facility elements; and
5. Pertinent budget and other governing factors.

The architects and building administrator of the project should involve the Bismarck School Board, the Superintendent, teachers, other certificated staff members, and student and citizen representatives in the development of educational specifications.

State and local officials such as the ADA coordinator, fire officials, and other public and private individuals may be used in the development of educational specifications when deemed necessary by the Superintendent and the School Board.
