

Relations with Colleges and Universities

The Board desires that staff and students of the District benefit in every feasible way from resources provided by the colleges and universities in our area. The Superintendent is to keep the Board informed of all opportunities for shared and cooperative services between the District and institutions of higher learning.

Professional Development and Continuing Education

The Superintendent or designee may seek out and utilize the services of college and university faculty members who are willing to serve our schools in staff development programs and as instructional resource persons. In planning post graduate and adult programs and in-service, the Board will work with area institutions of higher education so that programs will not be unnecessarily duplicated but will fit in with advanced training that these institutions offer.

Recruiting

The District will cooperate with recruiting efforts of post-secondary institutions so long as they do not unduly interfere with the school schedule. The Superintendent shall develop criteria and regulations for receiving college recruiters at district schools. Military recruiters shall be afforded the same opportunities as colleges and universities.

The District is required to provide an opt-out notice to families, and opt-out notification procedures are contained in the district's student educational records policy. In addition to following family opt-out decisions, BPS may further restrict release of directory information at its discretion.
