BPS creates dashboard of COVID case information

The BPS COVID-19 Team met yesterday to review a new dashboard of county and school district COVID case data which will be used to guide return-to-school decisions in Bismarck Public Schools. The dashboard includes county positive case rates and BPS student and staff COVID-related absences.

The 32-person BPS COVID Team, which includes staff, students and parents, meets weekly to study the impact that the start of school and BPS safety protocols have had on the spread of COVID-19.

From August 24 through September 6, Bismarck Public Schools brought athletes, staff and students back to school. The district's overall 14-day positive and quarantine rate was 1.8% or 287 staff and students out of a total of 15,647 students and employees. Of those, 29 were positive student and staff cases and 258 were quarantined as being close contacts.
